The Summer Enrichment STEAM Program strengthens academic skills while inspiring creativity and innovation through a full-day format. Students participate in academic enrichment in the morning, followed by hands-on STEAM activities in the afternoon. This engaging program challenges students, keeps them motivated, and sparks their imagination.

Avoiding the Summer Slump

Our full-day program is offered in weekly sessions designed to keep students safe, academically engaged, and excited about learning. Each week provides meaningful opportunities for students to explore new interests, build confidence, and stay connected to a structured learning environment throughout the summer.

What's Included

Weekly session costs vary and include:

- Small class sizes with academic enrichment lessons led by Randolph School faculty and staff
- Social and emotional development through structured activities with peers
- A differentiated learning approach tailored to each age group and grade level
- The option to extend the day with our late-stay program, which includes outdoor activities and interactive games (additional cost of \$110 per week)

MAY 26–29

Roar and Explore: Dinosaur Discovery STEAM Camp (4-Day Camp)

Step back in time and dig into science at Dino Discovery STEAM Camp! Young paleontologists will explore the prehistoric world through hands-on experiments, fossil digs, creative projects, and interactive games. This engaging camp sparks imagination and scientific thinking, perfect for curious minds ready to explore history's giants! Campers will:

- Learn how paleontologists study dinosaurs and other ancient creatures
- Discover how fossils form and what life was like millions of years ago
- Participate in activities like fossil digs, examining bones with microscopes, reconstructing dinosaurs, and creating model volcanoes

JUNE 1–5

Mission Invention: Mad Scientist Laboratory STEAM Camp (5-Day Camp)

Young inventors will explore science, technology, engineering, and math through the lens of history's greatest innovators. No experience needed—just curiosity and a love for building, tinkering, and experimenting! Campers will:

- Learn about inventors like Leonardo da Vinci, Thomas Edison, and Marie Curie
- Explore simple machines, circuits, and basic design thinking
- Build prototypes using recycled materials and craft supplies
- Take part in daily STEM challenges promoting teamwork, problem-solving, and creativity

JUNE 8–12

Camp Frostbite: Arctic Adventure STEAM Camp (5-Day Camp)

Bundle up for a frosty week of discovery! Campers will journey to the icy north through hands-on experiments, engineering challenges, and interactive games, learning about polar animals, frozen habitats, and Arctic science. Daily adventures include:

- Building a blubber glove to see how animals stay warm
- Experimenting with ice and insulation
- Navigating like an Arctic explorer
- Designing and testing sleds, snow shelters, and more!

JUNE 15–18

Camp Eureka!: Magic of Motion STEAM Camp (4-Day Camp)

Dive into the world of physics with playful experiments, creative projects, and engaging challenges. Kids learn by doing, moving, and experimenting—led by enthusiastic educators, combining STEM learning with play. Campers will explore gravity, magnetism, motion, sound, and simple machines through daily themes:

- Forces in Action: Push, pull, and watch things fly
- Simple Machines: Levers, pulleys, and gears made fun
- Air & Motion: Balloons, wind tunnels, and flying experiments
- Sound & Vibrations: Make waves with music and noise
- Light & Shadows: Explore reflections, rainbows, and more

JULY 6–10

Forensic Science Investigation Lab STEAM Camp (5-Day Camp)

Campers explore chemistry, biology, and physics to investigate crimes like professional forensic scientists. Campers will:

About Greengate Reading Camp

Greengate School's four-week summer program strengthens language and math skills for children with reading difficulties. Students receive daily reading tutorials from specialists trained in Orton-Gillingham instruction, an approach designed for bright children who struggle with reading, spelling, and writing. This program helps prevent summer learning loss, which can be especially pronounced for students with dyslexia.

This is for students entering grades 1-5 who:

- Have strong verbal abilities but struggle with reading, spelling, writing, and/or math
- Need continued summer instruction to maintain or grow academic skills
- Can work in a small group setting without major behavioral concerns
- Thrive in a multi-sensory learning environment

Additional details:

- No formal testing or learning diagnosis is required for eligibility
- Parent-submitted information and some pre-screening are required for acceptance
- Students with emotional or behavioral difficulties cannot be supported in this program; removal may occur if needs arise after the program begins (program fees are non-refundable)


