Randolph's Upper School is an engaging, challenging environment for students in 9th through 12th grade. We are proud of our rigorous academic program, wide-ranging extracurricular activities, nurturing environment, and culture of trust.

Beginning in 9th grade through graduation, our College Counseling Office works closely with students and families to provide the appropriate guidance and resources necessary to navigate the college admissions process. Our team strives to give every student the preparation and individual support they need to find the right fit for their university experience. Randolph graduates are not only prepared for acceptance to the higher institutions of their choice, but they are also ready to flourish there.

Virtually all Randolph graduates attend four-year colleges. Here are some statistics from the most recent graduating class (2023):

42% of students scored 30 or higher on the ACT or equivalent SAT score.

100% of students who sought merit-based financial aid received it.

100% of students have completed courses in Biology and Chemistry, an additional 36% have completed Physics or Honors Physics, and 41% have completed Calculus.

53% have taken four years of world language at the Upper School level.

Randolph School holds dual accreditation from SAIS/Cognia and is a member of the National, Southern and Alabama Associations of Independent Schools; the National and Southern Association for College Admission Counseling; The College Board; the National Honor Society; the Cum Laude Society; and Global Online Academy.

OUR STUDENT EXPERIENCE

We have 27 varsity teams playing 17 sports. 85% of our Upper School students participate in at least one sport; 35% play more than one sport. Over the past five years, Randolph has won five team state titles, including the 5A Varsity Boys Golf State Championship in the 2022-23 school year. From the class of 2023, four students will pursue their athletic endeavors in college, two at the D1 level.

The Upper School presents two major theatre productions a year, as well as band and choir concerts. We offer a multitude of visual, digital, and performing arts courses. Of recent graduating classes, 38% of students have taken four years of visual or performing arts. In the Class of 2023, 13 students plan to continue in the arts at the collegiate level as a major, minor, or in their free time.

All Randolph students adhere to a student-governed Honor System. The Community Learning Program connects them to meaningful service partnerships with organizations throughout North Alabama.

Interim Week gives every student the opportunity to learn outside the classroom through a wide array of trips, shadowing various careers, and service opportunities both locally and globally.

In the Class of 2023, 97% of students took at least one Advanced Placement course, with 84% taking 3 or more. The College Board recognized 15 students with AP Scholar Awards, 23 students with AP Scholar with Distinctions Awards, and five students with AP Scholar with Honors Awards. Two students achieved perfect scores on the ACT and/or SAT.

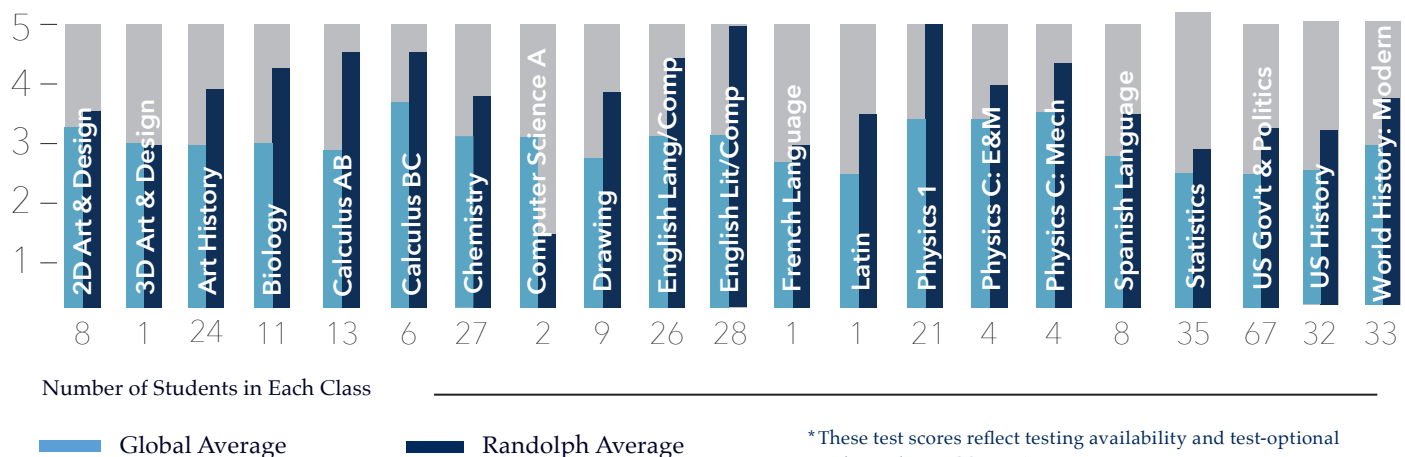

AP GUIDANCE

Randolph limits the number of Advanced Placement courses that each student may take. Tenth graders are approved to take one AP course. Eleventh graders may take up to three courses. Twelfth graders may take up to four courses. Students may petition to take one additional AP course beyond this limit.
